During our Ofsted Inspection in September 2010, one of the main points the Inspectors commented on is the need to improve attendance at New Hall & Primary Children's Centre. Currently attendance at our school is below the National Average of 94%.

We are writing to you requesting your help in raising our attendance from 93% to reach our target of 94% by the end of July 2011.
