Dear Parents/Carers

Team Roberts - Trip to Red Point Climbing Centre

This term Team Roberts have arranged a visit to the *Red Point Climbing Centre* in Birmingham on **Friday 2 December 2011**. The children will depart from school at approx 9.15am by public transport and return back by approx 3.00pm. This trip is part of the PE curriculum with the emphasis on team building.

The cost of the trip is **£13.50 per child (£4.50 a week for 3 weeks)**. This includes entrance fee, trained instructors and safety equipment including climbing shoes. We have spent a lot of time researching the cost of entrance fees of our trip locations and safe transport to and from venues, and we feel that we have sourced places that are not only value for money, educational and child friendly but most importantly safe and secure. **We ask for a voluntary contribution towards school trips, however, if there are not enough contributions towards the cost, we may have to cancel the trip. Payment cards are available at the school office. This will enable you to pay in installments at your convenience.**

On the day children will need to wear trainers, tracksuit bottoms or loose fitting trousers and a jumper / jacket that they can take off if they get warm climbing but keep on if they are cold whilst climbing. The children will also need to bring a packed lunch on the day. Any children entitled to free school meals may have sandwiches provided by the school if required.
